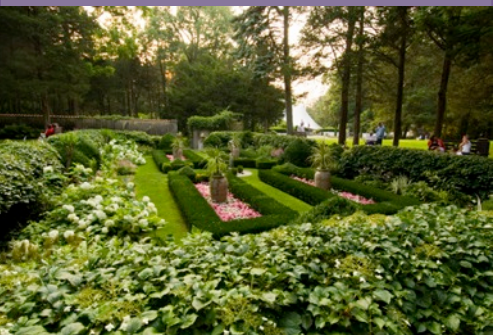



## TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

*NOTE: Transportation is not included in the price.  
Katonah, NY is about one hour from Manhattan.*

**BY TRAIN:** Metro North Harlem Line to Katonah via Grand Central Terminal (42<sup>nd</sup> Street)  
Suggested departure from GCT: 10:47 a.m. (arrives 12 p.m.)  
Suggested return to GCT: 6:33 p.m. (arrives 7:45 p.m.)

*For attendees taking the train, LDNY will engage taxis to pick up Dames and Guests upon arrival, and transport them throughout the day. Passengers will be then returned to Katonah train station for departure. LDNY will arrange a modest group rate that will be paid by attendees.*

**BY CAR:** Take the Henry Hudson to the Saw Mill River Parkway or the Hutchinson River Parkway to RT 684, to RT 35, Katonah Exit 6. At top of exit, turn right and get in the right lane for the light at RT 22 S. Take that right and it is about 1/4 of a mile on the left.
